

Hockey NL Return to Hockey Coach Guidelines

Coach 1 – Intro to Coach

For the 2020-2021 season all that coach/lead U7 and U9 programs must complete a training process which would include the following minimum requirements.

Option 1:

- Hockey University: NCCP Coaching Program Online – Coach 1/2
- Hockey University: RTH Safety Guidelines (new)
- Respect in Sport – Activity Leader program

Option 2: Member program through virtual delivery:

- Respect in Sport – Activity Leader program
- Hockey Canada Coach 1 (virtual Clinic)

COACH 2 – Coach Level

For the 2020-2021 season all Coaches that coach U11, U13, U15 and U18 community sport streams must complete a training process which would include the following minimum requirements.

Option 1:

- Hockey University: NCCP Coaching Program Online – Coach 1/2 (if not already completed)
- Hockey University: RTH Safety Guidelines
- Respect in Sport – Activity Leader program
- Checking Curriculum

Option 2: Member program through virtual delivery:

- Respect in Sport – Activity Leader program
- Hockey Canada Coach 2 (virtual Clinic)

All Coaches completing the coursework are to be provided with the following from each Member:

- Coach 2 – Coach Level Reference Materials (digital copy)
- Hockey Canada Network App Subscription

Plan for the 2020-21 season: Starting first week of November

- Early stages of the season offer a minimum of 3 Coach 1 virtual clinics for all coaches across the island.
- Early stages of the season offer a minimum of 3 Coach 2 virtual clinics for all coaches across the island.
- Offer 1 Coach 1 in class session per region if possible.
- Offer 1 Coach 2 in class session per region if possible.

* Virtual sessions would be held via Microsoft Teams. Instructions on how to join the call would be provided to all coaches prior to the clinic. All coaches in attendance would be asked to have their personal video turned on to promote attendance and participation.
