- Providing regular reports to the Executive as it relates to the functionality of all divisions
- Increasing player skill development at the house league and all-star levels
- Liaising with sport governing bodies and hockey organizations
- Conducting regular assessments of players and coaches at all levels
- Providing on-ice support to players and coaches at all levels
- Providing technical leadership and developing the all-star team tryout process
