Award Establishment:

This award was established by Mount Pearl Minor Hockey Association in conjunction with Gary Martin, the 2009 RBC Hockey Leadership Award Winner. This award is modeled after the National Award, a grass roots award presented annually to the person who consistently makes overall outstanding contributions towards the development of the Mount Pearl Minor Hockey Association.

Beginning with the 2017-18 season this Award will be presented annually to an individual for work ethic, dependability, impact, leadership, and enthusiasm. The individual leads with positive examples through: motivation of others and dedication to the overall betterment of the Mount Pearl Minor Hockey Association.

This award recognizes our most dedicated hockey volunteer and offers a chance to celebrate the unsung hockey volunteer who is the lifeblood of hockey in our community.

This award is open to any volunteer in the MPMHA that exemplifies volunteerism, community involvement, leadership, dedication, and commitment to minor hockey. Recipients may be male or female and of any age.

Selection of Winner:

The winner will be selected by a panel of community and hockey representatives ("Program Judges"). Eligible nominees will be selected based on nomination information provided by the nominators.

The Award Selection Committee will select the winner using the following criteria as guidelines:

- Proven dedication to community through hockey
- Positive impact on hockey and hockey players in their community
- Dependability, enthusiasm and leadership
- Acting as a positive role model to others
- High level of commitment

The announcement of the Winner will take place: April 18, 2018 at the Year End Banquet

- **Name engraved on perpetual plaque**
- **A keeper plaque.**

GUIDELINES / CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION

1. Nominations are to be completed and submitted directly to MPMHA Local Hockey Leadership Award committee c/o Mount Pearl Minor Hockey Association.
2. Nominations will be accepted from coaches, parents, referee's, board members or, past members of MPMHA. Nominations will also be accepted from the general public.
3. The MPMHA Local Hockey Leadership Award committee reserves the right to include additional nominations.
4. Nominations must be for amateur athletes, coaches, officials, executive members or volunteers who participate in minor hockey programs.
5. Professional athletes, coaches or officials are not eligible for nomination.
6. The Award will be based on a minimum of 5 years contribution to MPMHA.
7. The Selection Committee will consider the nominee's long term commitment and dedication. The Local Hockey Leadership Award Committee will make their final decision based solely on the information provided on the nomination form. Nominators should ensure that the nomination is accurate and as complete as possible.

8. The final decision regarding nominations and eligibility will rest with the committee.
9. **April 12, 2018 is the deadline for Nominations to be received.** Nominations after that date will not be accepted.
10. INCOMPLETE NOMINATION FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
ALL DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL.
